Message from the Founder



沒想到失控十年了!

自2014年的一張「舊鞋救命」海報在社群媒體引起迴響後,回頭看似失控的爆量結果,卻也是最好的安排,讓一場不平凡的路程就此展開。當年只是希望給非洲孩子一雙能保護雙腳的舊鞋,誰也沒料到十年後,我們的腳步不僅沒有停下,還走得更深更遠。如今,我們的工作不僅僅是揭鞋,還開展許多專案計畫,援助非洲的範疇越來越廣,影響越來越深。

當我和太太聊起這些年來的經歷時,我們心中最深的感動,其實不在於活動或專案本身有多成功;真正觸動我們的,是結識了這一路上無數奉獻時間、精力和金錢的支持者:這些年來有人奮不顧身的將資源投入,有人每個月跳上高鐵前往募集現場搬貨、曬一整天的太陽,有人一直默默的在電腦前回覆網友的提問;我們從沒想到在這裡會集結了一群人,和我們一起把這個使命當成「自己的事」!

I want to sincerely thank each and every one of you who has journeyed with us over the past ten years. Without you, there would be no Step30. It is because of you that we can continue to extend this love and mission throughout the world.




在台灣的經歷讓我深入了解亞洲文化與熱情好客,並與 多位支持者交流,分享肯亞的故事與挑戰。

「舊鞋救命計畫」以募集物資為起點,進入東 非偏鄉,解決當地村民因極度貧困無鞋可穿而 受沙蚤侵害的問題,因沙蚤會導致皮膚潰爛, 嚴重時甚至危及生命。自2014年啟動計畫以來 ,每次的募資總超乎想像,團隊更深入村落治 療並推廣正確衛教,至今已治療7萬名患者, 許多患者在痊癒後,也自願成為衛教志工,回 饋在地社區。

然而,仍有許多赤貧家庭生活在沙土上,髒亂 的環境依舊是沙蚤滋生的溫床。2021年開啟「 地板計畫」,透過低成本自然建築工法改造泥 十地做成堅固環保地板,不僅改善居住環境, 更創造就業機會。至今計畫成功培育19位當地 青年成為技師,透過所學的施工技術,青年們 不但為族人打造乾淨的家,還能增加收入,他 們猶如地板計劃的見證,改變村民想法加入改 造地板的行列。

計畫不僅僅是提供資源,更著重於培養在地人 才,產生實質的影響力。只有當整個村莊共同 參與,計畫才能夠持續運作,進而改變貧窮現 況,邁向光明的未來。

The Shoes for Life Project began as an effort to provide shoes for impoverished villages in East Africa, where extreme poverty left many barefoot and vulnerable to jigger infestations. These parasites cause severe wounds and, in extreme cases, can be life-threatening. Since 2014, overwhelming public support has enabled us to go beyond donations-offering medical treatment and health education. To date, we have treated 70,000 patients, many of whom have recovered and become volunteer health agents, giving back to their communities.

However, unsanitary living conditions remain a breeding ground for jiggers. In 2021, we launched the Nyumba Nzuri Project, using low-cost, eco-friendly construction techniques to replace dirt floors with durable, sustainable flooring. This not only improves living conditions but also creates jobs. So far, 19 local youths have been trained as skilled builders, using their expertise to provide safe homes while earning a stable income. Their success has inspired entire villages to join the movement.

Beyond providing aid, Step30 focuses on empowering local communities. True transformation happens when entire villages take part-ensuring lasting change and a future free from poverty.

東非偏鄉教育資源匱乏,學生們常在簡陋的環 境中學習,老師用唯一的教科書講課,孩子們 則用極短的鉛筆,甚至有女孩因經濟困難被迫 輟學嫁給年長男子,這些都是當地受教孩童遇 到的艱難學習景況。然而,來自台灣的物資貨 櫃帶來了希望。

興學計畫

Vessel of Hope

興學計畫致力提供學童穩固安全的的學習環境 並提供各種技職培訓,執行至今已成功改建 108個貨櫃為教室,興建73間磚造校舍並持續 進行中。今年,在Bondeni村莊更展現計畫的 連貫性,貨櫃被改造為診所員工的辦公室和醫 療紀錄儲藏室,提升醫療品質,搭配半年前透 過活水計畫開鑿的水井,乾淨的水資源加上更 加完善的醫療服務,執行計畫相輔相助,大大 改善當地居民的生活。

透過實踐教育改寫貧困的命運,再透過各項計 畫的緊密連結,形成完整的轉型藍圖,打造持 續發展的系統,讓村莊朝向自主發展邁進,逐 步擺脫貧窮,踏上新希望的路途。

In rural East Africa, education is a daily struggle. Students learn in makeshift classrooms, teachers rely on a single textbook, and children write with worn-down pencils. Some girls, due to poverty, are forced to drop out and enter early marriages. Yet, hope arrives with container shipments from Taiwan.

相輔相成,邁向自主發展 Building a Path to Self-Sufficiency

The Vessel of Hope Project is dedicated to providing safe learning environments and vocational training. To date, we have converted 108 shipping containers into classrooms and built 73 brick school classrooms, with more underway. This year, in Bondeni Village, the project's impact expanded-containers were transformed into offices and medical record storage for clinic staff, improving healthcare services. Combined with a new borehole dug six months ago through the Living Water Project, access to clean water and better medical care is transforming lives.

By empowering education and integrating development projects, we are building a self-sustaining system that helps villages break free from poverty and move toward a future filled with hope.

在日常生活中,打開水龍頭就能隨時享用自來 水;然而,在撒哈拉沙漠以南地區,月降雨量 不到10毫米,居民每天必須翻山越嶺取水,取 得的還是充滿病菌的汙水,身陷疾病風險。

活水計畫在偏鄉建設水井,提供村民乾淨穩定 的水源,滿足飲水需求之外,貧瘠的土地也開 始回春,村民甚至能種植蔬菜,豐富飲食,進 而提升健康與醫療品質。例如在馬拉威Juma 村莊的水井建置,也讓年輕人重新返鄉,投入 農業生產,推動當地社區的經濟成長。

目前團隊已在6個國家開鑿超過77口水井,也 根據當地情況創新取水模式。前幾年在索馬利 蘭建設以雨水蒐集為基礎的集水壩,儲存的水 資源更使周遭土地植被重生,促進當地的畜牧 業發展。而落成後的水井或設施會交由當地社 區管理維護,使居民們在用水過程中也負起維 護責任;意識到這口水井是屬於「村莊社群的 」,而不是「慈善機構要負責的」,如此才能 永續經營。未來活水計畫將持續拓展至更多地 區,針對不同地區的水源挑戰探索實施因地制 宜的取水方案,為更多貧困乾旱的區域帶來復 甦生機的機會與希望。

For many, clean water is just a tap away. Yet, in sub-Saharan Africa, where monthly rainfall is often less than 10mm, families must trek long distances for contaminated water, risking severe illness.

The Living Water Project builds boreholes in remote villages, providing safe and stable water sources. Beyond drinking water, these boreholes revitalize barren land, enabling villagers to grow vegetables, improve nutrition, and enhance healthcare. In Juma, Malawi, access to clean water has even encouraged young people to return home and invest in agriculture, boosting the local economy.

To date, we have drilled over 77 boreholes across six countries, adapting solutions to local needs. In Somaliland, for example, we constructed rainwater-harvesting dams, which have restored vegetation and supported livestock farming. Every borehole is entrusted to the community for maintenance, fostering a sense of ownership rather than dependence on chari-

The Living Water Project continues to expand, developing custom water solutions for different regions-bringing life, growth, and renewed hope to those in need.

在非洲偏鄉,農民長期種植單一作物玉米,收 成不穩加上缺乏農業知識,容易陷入糧食困境 。農耕放牧計畫透過教學小組與示範中心傳遞 有機農法技術並提高作物多樣性,經過多年推 進,農作物產量顯著改善,豐富了村民餐桌, 2024年8月,計畫更實現新的藍圖--教學示範 中心的擴建,進而提供村民更完善的學習資源 ,為社區帶來正向發展。

然而,有更多位於半乾燥沙漠地帶的部落,因 過度放牧和氣候變遷加劇土壤貧瘠,村民不得 不越境尋找牧草,生活困境日益加劇。2022年 開始,團隊推動「放牧計畫」,與在地牧人溝 通改變傳統放牧,實施分區輪牧,藉由牲畜的 排泄物為貧瘠土壤補充養分,調整放牧方式荒 蕪土壤重獲牛機,草源和牛活逐漸恢復和穩定 ,減少跨國放牧的需求。

「授人以魚,不如授人以漁」,透過農耕計畫 和放牧計畫相互配合,讓村民學會與土地共生 ,助力偏鄉脫離對外來援助,實現自給自足的 永續生活。

In rural parts of East Africa, farmers have long relied on monoculture-mainly maize-which results in unstable harvests and food insecurity due to limited agricultural knowledge. The Green Life Project teaches organic farming techniques and promotes crop diversity through training groups and demonstration centers. After years of implementation, crop yields have improved significantly, enriching villagers' diets. In August 2024, the project expanded its training center, providing better learning resources and fostering positive community development.

However, tribes in semi-arid desert regions face increased soil degradation from overgrazing and climate change, forcing villagers to cross borders in search of grazing land. In 2022, the team launched an initiative for grazing management, collaborating with local herders to shift from traditional grazing to rotational grazing. This method replenishes depleted soils with manure from livestock, reviving barren land and stabilizing both grazing resources and livelihoods, reducing the need for cross-border grazing.

By combining the agriculture and grazing projects, we follow the principle of "Give them a fishing pole, and they become fishermen", enabling villagers to live sustainably with the land, and helping them move toward self-sufficiency-free from reliance on outside aid.

「舊鞋救命」一直鼓勵青年勇敢踏出舒適圈, 深入偏鄉,親身了解非洲的故事。疫情結束後 ,國際志工再次踏上肯亞,重逢熟悉的面孔, 並驚喜地見證多年來點滴耕耘所帶來的改變。 這次重返的旅程,不僅讓志工們看見了努力的 成果,也深刻體會到持續行動的重要性,為未 來帶來更多希望與可能性。

2016 年,Ann 第一次參加舊鞋救命的國際志工團,那趟旅程讓她明白,透過志工服務也能改變生命。多年後重返熟悉的肯亞偏鄉,讓她最感動的是親眼看見孩子們在更好的學習環境裡讀書,多年來點滴改變的耕耘成果在當地逐漸顯現。

同樣深受觸動的還有婕寧。八年前,她在大學 時參加國際志工團,在育幼院中結識了一位罹 患罕見脊髓疾病的孩童。2024年,帶著期待 與擔憂,她再次踏上肯亞偏鄉的土地。出乎預 料的是,她見到那位孩子在機構的照顧下長高 了不少,身上也穿著來自台灣的愛心物資,這 一幕讓她深深感受到持續關懷的力量。

透過國際志工的親身經歷,我們見證了點滴耕 耘的累積,也看見了當地真實的改變。這些故 事不是偶然的奇蹟,而是「舊鞋救命」與每位 國際志工多年來共同付出的成果。我們每一次 探訪、每一次努力,都讓當地居民感受到來自 異地的真心關懷。這份力量不僅改變了孩子的 生命,也為整個社區帶來了積極的轉變,讓翻 轉的希望在偏鄉扎根成長。 Step30 has always encouraged youth to step out of their comfort zones and experience Africa firsthand. After the pandemic, international volunteers returned to Kenya, reunited with familiar faces, and were amazed by the changes from years of consistent effort. This return not only showcased the fruits of their labor but emphasized the importance of ongoing action, bringing renewed hope for the future.

In 2016, Ann joined Step30's international volunteer team, and the experience showed her how volunteer work can change lives. Returning to rural Kenya years later, she was moved by seeing children studying in improved learning environments—proof that small efforts have paid off over time.

Similarly, Janet, who met a child with a rare spinal disease at an orphanage during her university years, returned to Kenya in 2024 with mixed emotions. She was overjoyed to see the child had grown taller and was wearing donated clothes from Taiwan. This moment underscored the power of continuous care. Through these experiences, we' ve witnessed the true impact of these efforts. The stories are not just miraculous moments but the result of years of collaboration between Step30 and international volunteers. Each visit, each effort, has brought lasting change to the community, allowing hope to take root in Kenya's rural areas.

舊鞋救命從2014年開始逐步深入非洲偏鄉,發展各項計畫,從沙蚤治療、建設學校、挖掘水井、推廣農業技術...等等,都歸因於貧困問題的影響環環相扣,計畫必須在同一地區同步推動,才能為村民的生活帶來整體的改變。

Khalwenge是早期在肯亞投入計畫的第一站, 也是見證「偏鄉翻轉」夢想藍圖實現的地點之 一。2024年隨著農耕教學示範中心的擴建,進 一步提供村民完整的教學課程,為翻轉的願景 藍圖增添一筆重要進展。

而每週末在村莊辦理的兒童營會,藉由聖經的學習強化下一代的品格教育;定期舉辦的星星市集活動,也讓孩子們有機會以課堂累積的點數兌換獎品。而當我們看見孩子從最初為自己兌換糖果,到為家人兌換實用物品(台灣捐贈的二手鞋、衣服、包包)的轉變,都歸功於長期陪伴所建立的信任感及正確價值觀的培養;營會的課程參與也能幫助年輕人遠離負面影響,避免流浪街頭。

未來十年,將持續深耕非洲偏鄉,透過六大計 畫幫助更多貧困地區擺脫依賴援助思維。隨著 越來越多村民走向自立生活,偏鄉翻轉的未來 藍圖逐漸實現,最終得以終結世代貧困,迎接 全新的未來。 Since 2014, Step30 has been deeply involved in rural Africa, developing initiatives like jigger treatment, school construction, borehole drilling, and agricultural training. These projects are all interconnected, as poverty's effects require simultaneous solutions in the same region to create lasting change.

Khalwenge, one of the first areas in Kenya to implement these projects, has become a symbol of village transformation. In 2024, the expansion of the agricultural training center further strengthens the educational opportunities available to the villagers, marking a significant step forward in our vision.

Each weekend, the children's camps use Bible teachings to help shape the next generation's character. Regular Star Market events also give children the chance to exchange points for rewards. Over time, we've seen a shift—from children redeeming points for candy to exchanging them for useful items like second—hand shoes, clothes, and bags donated from Taiwan. This change reflects the trust built through long-term engagement and the development of positive values.

In the next ten years, we will continue our efforts in Africa's rural areas. Through integrated projects, we aim to help more communities move away from aid dependency. As more villagers achieve self-sufficiency, the rural transformation vision will continue to take shape, ultimately ending generational poverty and ushering in a brighter future.











偏鄉翻轉



耶穌曾對門徒說:「要收的莊稼多,做工的人 少」,因此MOVE差會渴望回應這份呼召,積 極動員與招募華人青年進入工人與資源最匱乏 的未得之民群體中。效法耶穌道成肉身的榜樣 ,宣教士們選擇長期委身,不僅傳遞完整的福 音,更以建立當地獨立成熟的教會為最終目標 ,讓福音得以自主延續,並在地生根。

MOVE深知,神將大使命託付給「教會」,因 此始終秉持與本地教會連結的核心精神,與教 會共同預備與差派宣教士,並重視宣教士與教 會間持續性的健康關係。透過完善的機制,包 括宣教十關顧、禾場顧問制度、系統化的宣教 訓練與差會經驗,幫助宣教士穩健服事。

2024年,又有MOVE與教會共同差派兩位宣教 士抵達肯亞基地,至今已累計四位宣教士投入 禾場,並展開Swahili語言學習;而先行抵達 者已完成第一階段檢定,預計完成四階段語言 訓練。今年5月,有兩位新夥伴完成宣教訓練 與差會實習,正著手預備差派;9月也有兩位 宣教士加入新學期訓練。

除了實際差派宣教士,MOVE亦持續深化與教 會、夥伴差會、機構與神學院的合作, 並規劃 宣教實習機會,向神學院與未來牧者分享異象 。期待更多基督徒與教會一同回應宣教呼召, 成就萬國萬民都來敬拜神的榮耀使命。

Jesus said, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." MOVE Mission seeks to respond to this call by mobilizing and equipping Chinese young people to serve among the unreached people groups, where workers and resources are scarce. Following Jesus' incarnational model, missionaries commit to long-term service, bringing the full gospel and establishing independent, mature churches to ensure sustainable growth and expansion.

MOVE recognizes that God has entrusted the Great Commission to the Church, Therefore, we uphold the mission of partnering with local churches to prepare and send missionaries while fostering ongoing, healthy relationships between them. Through a well-structured system-including missionary care, field advisory mechanisms, comprehensive training, and the experience of the mission organization-MOVE equips missionaries to serve with stability.

In 2024, MOVE and partnered churches jointly sent two missionaries to Kenya, bringing the total to four. They have begun Swahili language training, with the earlier missionaries having completed the first proficiency level, aiming to complete all four. In May, two new candidates completed their mission training and internship, preparing for deployment, while two others joined the new semester's training in September.

In addition to sending missionaries, MOVE continues to deepen partnerships with churches, mission agencies, organizations, and seminaries. We also plan mission internship opportunities to share the vision with seminaries and future pastors. We look forward to seeing more Christians and churches respond to the missionary calling and join in the glorious mission of leading all nations to worship God.







